

Competencies in National Certificate in Security Level 2 (Version 7)

Generics

US 497: Demonstrate knowledge of workplace health and safety requirements (L1 C3)

- identify and describe legislative rights and responsibilities for workplace health and safety;
- describe the systems approach to workplace health and safety; and,
- explain how hazards are defined in the HSE Act.

US 505: Manage personal physical fitness with guidance (nb "with guidance) (L1 C3)

- assess personal levels of physical fitness using reliable techniques;
- develop and produce a personal exercise plan based on results of personal fitness assessment; and,
- implement the personal exercise plan and measure progress in relation to goals.

US 548: Plan to manage personal use of alcohol and other drugs (L1 C2)

- demonstrate knowledge of, and identify strategies for the safer use of, alcohol and other drugs.

US 1294: Be interviewed in a formal situation (L2 C2)

- able to plan, prepare for, and be interviewed in a formal interview.

US 1304: Communicate with people from other cultures (L2 c2)

- demonstrate knowledge of communication with people from other cultures and,
- communicate with people from other cultures.

US 3503: Participate in a team or group to complete routine tasks (L1 C2)

- able to identify team or group roles and responsibilities in relation to a routine task, and,
- participate and communicate within a team or group to complete a routine task.

First Aid:

Fire:

US 3271: Suppress fire with hand extinguishers and fixed hose reels (L2 C1)

- able to demonstrate knowledge of the fire classes and fire suppression techniques, and
- select and implement a strategy to deal with fire.

US 12348: Demonstrate knowledge of anger and options for dealing with anger issues (L1 C2)

- describe anger and how anger operates in, and affects, people's lives; and,
- identify options for addressing anger.

US12355: Demonstrate knowledge of stress and ways of dealing with it (L2 C2)

- able to describe stress and its common sources and effects, and
- describe ways of dealing with stress.

Security Specific

US 20596: Demonstrate knowledge required for employment in the security industry (L2 C5)

- describe aspects of law and compliance relevant to security and related best practice;
- describe anger and stress relevant to security, and best practice response;
- describe the effects of the misuse of alcohol and other drugs, and related best practice responses;
- describe health and safety requirements relevant to security staff;
- describe interpersonal communication techniques relevant to security;
- describe crowd and traffic control measures and techniques relevant to security;
- complete a pre-formatted minor security incident report.

US 21105: Demonstrate introductory knowledge of the security industry (L2 C2)

- describe basic concepts of security;
- demonstrate knowledge of the major services provided by security organisations, and their users; and
- describe major employment roles in the security industry.

US 21106: Demonstrate knowledge of law relevant to security officers (L2 C7)

- describe the key provisions of the Private Investigators and Security Guards Act 1974;
- describe the relevance of New Zealand Law as it relates to security officers;
- explain the legal powers of a security officer and their application;
- demonstrate knowledge of trespass and its application for security officers; and
- describe the elements of specified crimes.

US 21107: Demonstrate communication skills as a security officer (L2 C10)

- demonstrate literacy skills for the security workplace;
- write standard security reports and records;
- interact with people in a security context;
- communicate with people with impaired communication abilities and in difficult situations;
- conduct a front-line interview; and
- operate and care for a radio-telephone.

US 21108: Demonstrate knowledge of professional standards required of a security officer (L2 C6)

demonstrate knowledge of:

- personal presentation;
- personal standards; and
- time management required of a security officer.
