Compulsory component

All of NCiS L2 plus:

US 6519: Demonstrate knowledge of protective security (L3 C7)

- explain the purpose and function of protective security; and
- describe security officers' roles and responsibilities.

US 6523: Respond to emergencies and critical situations as a security officer (L3 C6)

- respond to fire and other emergencies;
- conduct evacuations;
- respond to bomb threats; and
- take preventative action with respect to potential hazards as a security officer.

US 20595: Demonstrate knowledge of the threat presented by terrorism (L3 C4)

- describe terrorism and its principal characteristics;
- describe specific terrorist incidents;
- identify security measures that may be used to reduce the risks presented by terrorism to a specific target.

US 21109: Demonstrate knowledge of security staff interaction with the legal system (L3 C5)

- explain police responsibilities, requirements, and procedure; and
- describe the judicial system and procedure in relation to the security industry.

US21110: Demonstrate knowledge of and operate electronic equipment as a security officer (L3 C5)

demonstrate knowledge of and operate:

- electronic communications equipment;
- electronic security systems and equipment; and
- computer system equipment.

US 21737: Manage violence and personal safety as a security officer (L3 C8)

- describe the risk of violence;
- assess risk to personal safety;
- respond to violence and minimise the risk to personal safety in a non-violent manner;
- manage activities immediately following violence; and
- describe personal recovery strategies and procedures following violence.

US 21738: Demonstrate lawful use of force in a security context (L4 C10)

- explain the legal powers of a security officer in relation to the use of force and explain their application in a security context;
- -demonstrate communication techniques used in critical situations; and
- demonstrate knowledge and the use of physical techniques for security officers in critical situations.

US 21739: Manage security incidents, breaches, and suspects as a security officer (L4 C10)

- describe and assess security incidents and breaches;
- -respond to security incidents and breaches;
- identify, observe, and process suspects; and
- report and record security incidents and breaches.
